

2015-2016 Math Bowl Registration Instructions Grades 1 - 5



All Math Bowls will take place at the TPepin Hospitality Center. Each grade level will have two competitions. Each school will attend only one competition (morning or afternoon). Awards will be given out at each competition (morning and afternoon sessions). Schools will be assigned a session (morning or afternoon) based upon their area.

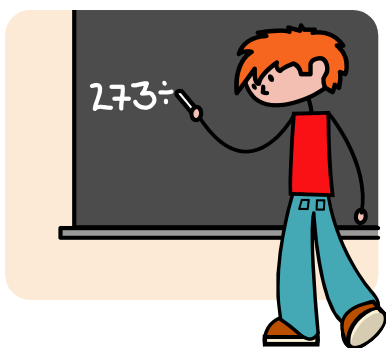
All Math Bowl registrations will be completed online via: www.mathcouncil.com

Registration will be available in October. Do not attempt to register earlier as your registration will be wiped out during our website revision.

- Directions on registering for Math Bowl will be on www.mathcouncil.com in October.
- Following your online registration process, you will still be required to print out two forms:
 - Registration and Payment Verification form:
 - This form verifies that you have registered online and indicates your method of payment (membership with events included, single payment, etc)
 - Payment (\$50.00 per team) must be mailed through school mail with verification form. If payment was made via HCTM membership, check appropriate box on form. Payment is due prior to scheduled event/s.

 - Media Release form:
 - The media release form must be printed out and brought on the day of the competition. This form will verify that all students in attendance have a signed media release form on file at the school site.
